Supplies: Advanced Painting

NOTE: Quantities below are only suggestions – you already know how you use painting tools and at what rate. All of us are different in this regard, and therefore - please buy what you know you will need. You may bring additional supplies that you prefer such as watercolor pencils, gel medium, etc.

- Small Journal/ Sketchbook for jotting down ideas, techniques, sketches
- Drawing pencil and eraser
- Watercolor paper 18" by 24" or similar size
- Masking tape
- Artist grade set of acrylic paints
- Artist grade set of paint brushes in various sizes/shapes
- A sturdy and useable palette. This can be a wooden, plastic or metal or a large disposable paper palette.
- Pallet knife
